

COHEN VS. SUBARU CASE FILE

The Case File includes all legal filings by all parties. Annexes are not included as they are not particularly relevant or interesting and would make an already somewhat confusing case even more so. In addition, they include numerous documents that would be problematic from a privacy standpoint to publish online. While a few of them are interesting, it could be viewed as potentially biased to only include only some but not all, therefore, a partial inclusion was not an option.

All correspondence to and from all parties are also included. The only exception was a long letter I received several years ago. It enraged me to such a point that I threw it away immediately as I never wanted to see it again. Not a wise move in hindsight, although I am quite sure that Subaru is glad it is no longer around to publish.

The documents can be reviewed in one of three ways.

1. A [Table of Contents](#) that links to all documents. Each PDF can then be viewed individually.
2. The [entire case file](#) in a single PDF is available. It is large, and will take about 30 seconds to load. Once loaded it can be saved and viewed offline.
3. All documents can also be browsed using an [accordion index](#). It allows for fast viewing of an analysis of each document, which also contain links to each PDF.
